A meeting of the Human Resources/Policy Committee of the Board of Education of Community Unit School District 200, DuPage County, Illinois, was called to order at 12:00 PM at the School Service Center, 130 W Park Avenue, Wheaton, IL, on Thursday, April 18, 2019.

Review of Draft Policy Manual

A draft of the policy manual was received from IASB in March. The District has sixty days to review the manual internally. The committee has been reviewing the draft of the manual by section. Dr. Schuler reviewed the policy review process, which will result in the following:

- Identification of policies with no recommended changes from the current D200 policy to the PRESS recommended policy.
- Policy recommendations with non-substantive changes.
- Policy recommendations with substantive changes (will bring before the full Board for discussion).
- Policies in which the District will maintain the current D200 policy.

The committee has reviewed sections 1-4, 6 and 8 previously, with the goal being to review the following sections of the policy manual at this meeting:

- Section 5 – Personnel
- Section 7 – Students

There were questions/comments/discussion on the following:

- The policies to review with the Finance Committee.
- The policies to review with legal counsel.
- The policies which require further consultation with either Senior Leadership Team, Building Administrative Team members or D200 staff.

Dr. Schuler summarized the following policies will be included as part of a discussion item at a future Board of Education meeting: policies 5.30.1, 5.40, 5.90, 5.100, 5.190, 7.25, 7.50, 7.110, 7.145, 7.180, 7.230, 7.270, 7.275, 7.310, 7.315, 7.340, 7.350, 7.360, and 7.370. It was determined these policies require feedback and discussion from the full Board. A meeting is scheduled in early May with the IASB policy consultant to edit the draft policy manual. Additional meetings will be scheduled as necessary.
